NACo releases new COVID-19 resources

Last night, the U.S. Senate passed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The bill (H.R. 748) now heads to the U.S. House for passage before heading to President Trump's desk for his signature. **The massive relief package — the biggest in U.S. history — contains many measures important to counties.**

The National Association of Counties (NACo) **released a comprehensive analysis** highlighting relevant components of the CARES Act for county governments, including a section-by-section breakdown outlining items of significance for America's counties, parishes and boroughs.

NACo has also released a **comprehensive slide deck** on counties and COVID-19.
